Order 2022 No 341
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Footpaths 20.58/8/1, Scorton and 20.52/5/2, North Cowton, between grid references NZ27970319 and NZ26230156, as the bridge is due to be replaced but, due to budgetary constraints, we are unsure when a new bridge will be installed, has been continued in force for a further twelve months until 4th April 2025 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

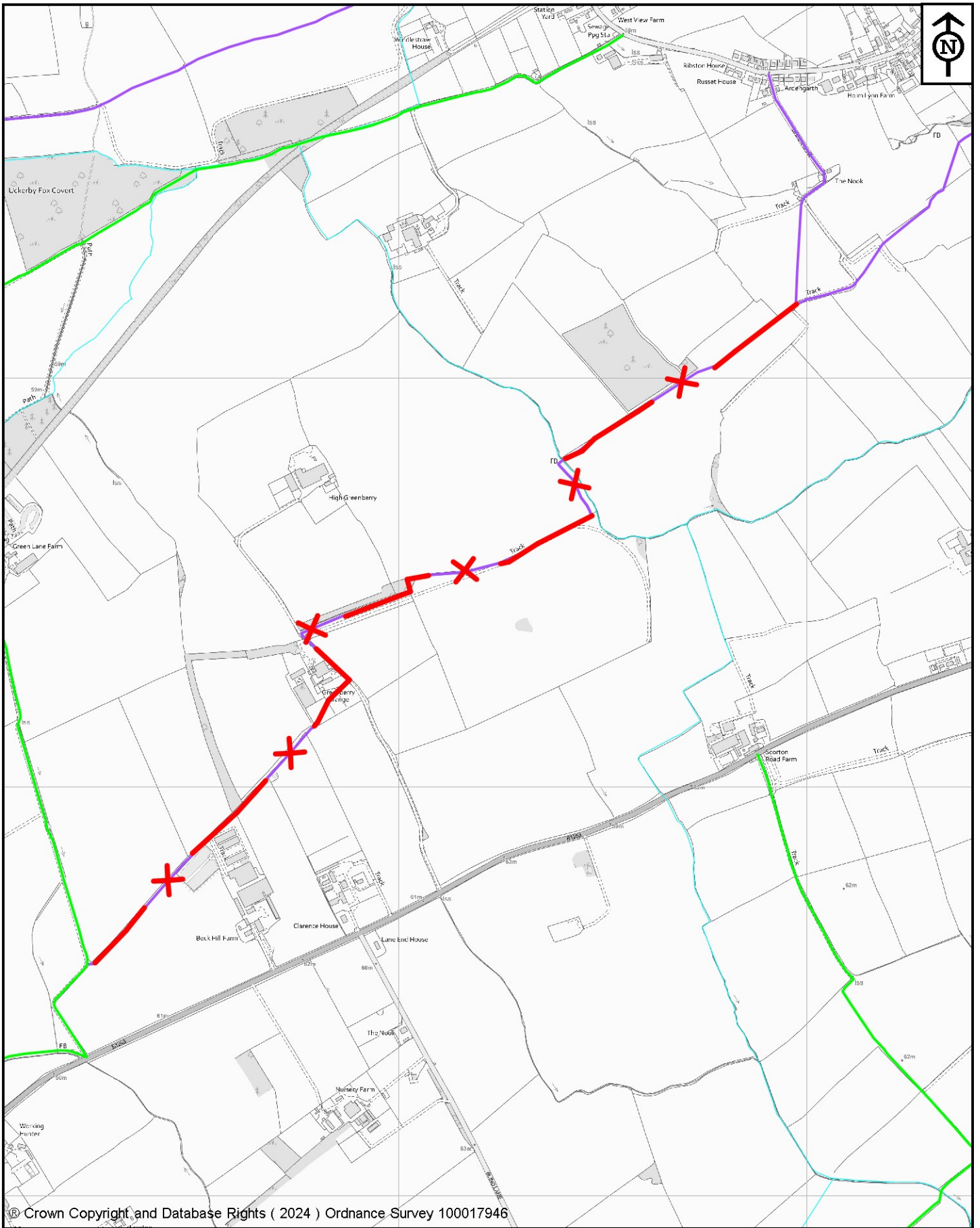
The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs.
