

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS)  
PUBLIC FOOTPATHS 05.5/22/2, 05.5/21/1 & 05.5/33/3, BENTHAM  
ORDER 2024 NO 129  
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 05.5/22/2, 05.5/21/1 & 05.5/33/3 in the Parish of Bentham, between grid references SD66376924, SD65906914 and SD65716908 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 24<sup>th</sup> April 2024 and 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024 due to footpath collapse. This Order follows Emergency Notice No 120.

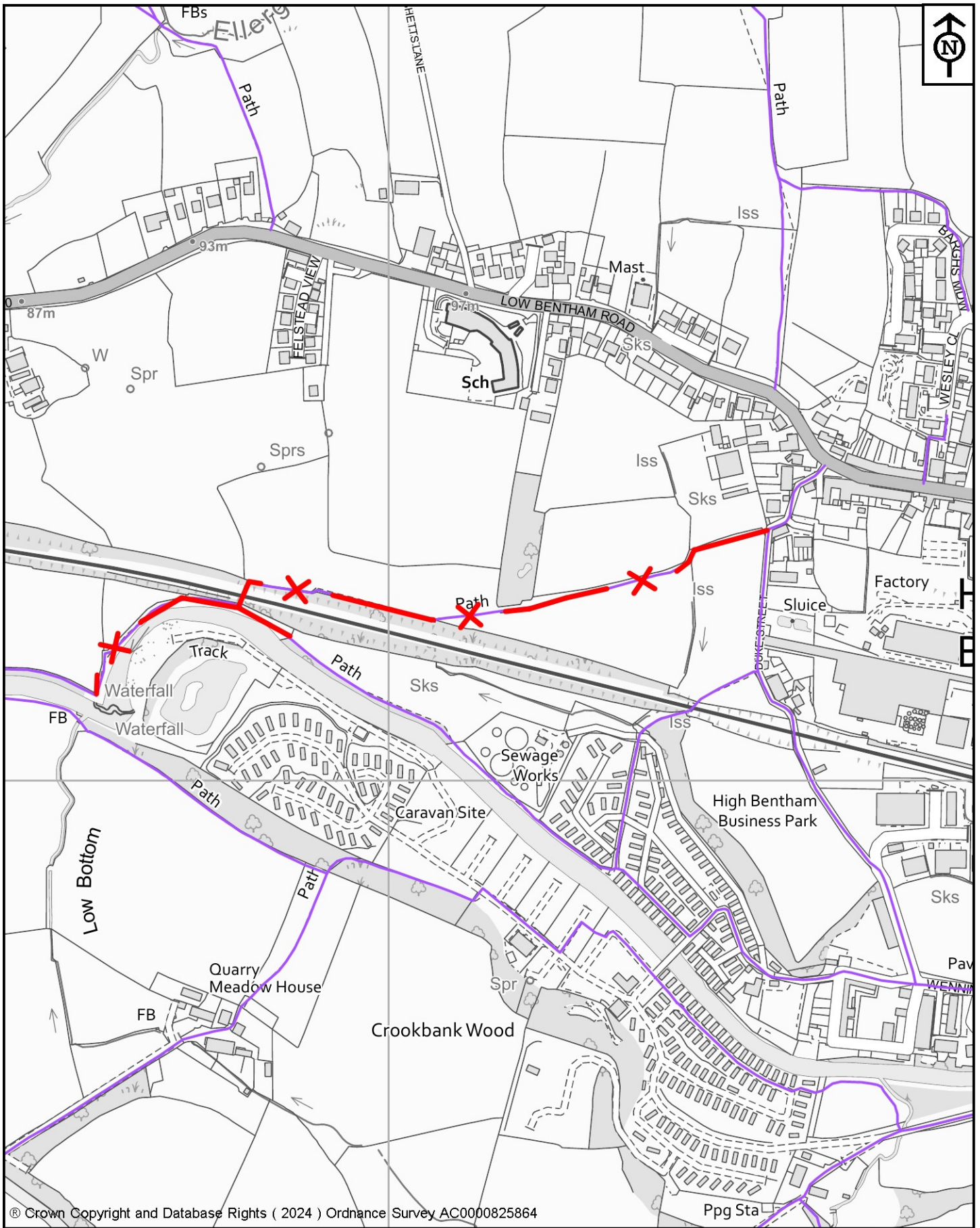
The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.

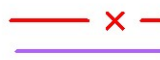
